Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to the Summer Term. I hope you all had a good break and enjoyed some sunshine in between the showers!

There is a lot to pack in this term as we enter the more formal assessment period for nearly all year groups, with Year 1 phonics screening, Year 2 SATs, Year 4 Multiplication Checks and Year 6 SATS.

Our children's mental health is a continual concern and a priority for us, so any child sitting a formal assessment will be looked after, given time (within what we are allowed) to do their best and some will not even realise they are doing it at all! If you have any questions, please speak to your child's class teacher.

In amongst all of this will be lots of sports, 2 class trips, visitors into school, extra events and celebrations.

The Coronation – School celebration on Friday 5th May

To mark the Coronation of King Charles, we will be having a celebration in school on Friday 5th May, in the afternoon. We would like the children to come into school dressed as royalty for the day (this can include princess costumes or their own clothes with royal accessories!) We would also like the children to bring in something "sweet" that they can eat in the afternoon, this could be a fairy cake, a jam tart or a few biscuits. School will provide the drinks. The children will be once again learning some country dances to share with each other and learn some playground games that King Charles may have played when he was young. This event, I afraid, is NOT open to parents but photos will be shared on the website. There will, however be a little something shared with at home time!

Forest School

Forest School will continue for Maple Class and will start on **Wednesday 19th April** for **Chestnut Class** and then after half term for Oak. (Some dates may need to be changed for Oak as there is a clash with other events- you will be sent the dates for Forest School nearer the half term week.)

Please make sure your children have suitable clothes, waterproofs, a coat and wellies in school, otherwise they will not be allowed to join in with the session.

Please also be respectful about your tone and words used in messages to staff via email or Class Dojo. Consider whether a conversation would be better instead and if so, either ring to make an appointment or to talk to the staff member or see them in the morning to arrange a meeting.

We, in school spend a lot of time looking after your children's mental health and it is my job to also look after the staff. Please respect the fact that staff have feelings too.
