## JOB DESCRIPTION

## Main purpose

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To ensure that all children have a meaningful lunchtime play every day. To help create a safe and stimulating outdoor environment that offers social, active, and creative play experiences for all.

- To maintain and order and the safe transfer of pupils to and from the dining room
- To positively encourage good behavior and table manners and hygiene
- To assist younger pupils where necessary whilst they are taking a meal
  - To activity supervise the dining room procedures:-
    - Carrying of meal to the table
    - Assisting with the service at the table
    - Training children in the correct use of cutlery
    - Clearing and stacking table equipment and servicing dishes
    - Wiping and re-setting tables if necessary
    - $\circ$   $\,$  Clearing up food and water spillages on tables and floors
    - To report to the head teacher in the case of absence due to illness
- To administer first aid in the case of a minor accident acting on the advice of the register first-aider. Record accidents in the first aid record and report serious accidents to the head teacher
- Be responsible for organising play activities in the playground or indoors if a wet playtime
- To liaise with the head teacher and teaching staff or the school in dealing with problems arising from pupil behavior and any other matters of concern
- To contribute as a member of a team to the ethos and environment of the school
- To always adhere to and practice confidentiality
- To perform such other duties as reasonably correspond to the general character of the post and are commensurate with its level of responsibility
